Concerning Purchase of Real Property, Talus Corporate Center, LLC - 6:32 p.m.

Ms. Callan moved the Board adopt Resolution No. 1128 concerning the Acquisition of Real Property located in the City of Issaquah, King County, Washington, having a tax parcel number of 856273-0170 (the "Talus Property"), as presented.

Ms. Weaver seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously. Dr. Gallinger was not present.

Prior to the vote on the motion, Jacob Kuper, CFO, outlined the details surrounding the property; approximately 9 acres at a cost of \$16.5M, and described as a friendly sale in lieu of condemnation. The property would be a suitable site for Middle School #6 with a projected opening date of September 2021.

Mr. Kuper also explained that with this purchase the money set aside from the 2016 bond would still leave funds in reserve.

The site of the old Administration Service Center at 565 NW Holly Street had originally been slated for MS #6 would now be set aside for future use.

Steve Crawford, Executive Director of Capital Projects, discussed possible design plans for MS #6.

Superintendent Thiele recommended the purchase of this property.
