Indoor Environment Facility Concern Form Instructions

Outline protocol for reporting environmental quality concern/issue:

Step	Action
1.	Any employee, student, or community member who has a concern about indoor
	environmental quality presents this issue to school secretary or custodian in writing on
	appropriate form. This form shall be available in each school office and on the District Intra-
	net. Note that this form should not be used for routine work orders such as temperature
	control, equipment repairs, etc. Please call Karen Miller at extension 5081 for clarification.
2.	Secretary/Custodian enters a work order in SchoolDude (a software program) using air quality
	as the purpose code. The work order includes names of concerned parties, room/areas
	affected, description of concern(s), and a timeline that includes any history of the problem.
3.	Facilities Services will investigate and communicate with school custodian, principal, IEA Safe
	and Healthy Work Environment group, and the concerned party within one working day. All
	groups shall have access to the concern form.
4.	Facilities Services develops appropriate action plan and updates work order system to reflect
	plan or resolution. They also communicate plan to concerned parties, including the person
	who has raised the issue, and the IEA Safe & Healthy Working Environment group.
5.	Work order is closed upon completion and history of work is recorded in the work order
	system. The IEA/ISD Joint Committee for a Safe & Healthy Working Environment shall review
	and monitor concerns at their joint meetings. Facilities staff informs all parties in writing when
	the process has reached completion.
